Brian Davey has a background in the coal and power sector with more than 30 years' experience in the operations, financial, marketing and technology sectors of the industry.

Brian commenced his career with the SECV in the Latrobe Valley and worked in a variety of roles and was promoted to General Manager level. On privatization Brian joined a newly created private power entity in a senior management role and took up management positions in HR, Operations and Marketing.

In 2004 Brian left the company to form a consultancy that specialised in HR and business advice and undertook a range of projects that included Business and HR restructuring, negotiation of individual workplace agreements with a start-up coal technology company and strategic HR advice to a large logistics company.

In 2005 Brian was recruited to develop, implement and manage an advanced coal technology program for the Victorian State government. A succession of technology programs followed until Brian left government service in 2013 and returned to full time consultancy working with international clients to advance lignite projects in India and Indonesia.

In late 2016 Brian was recruited by Regional Development Victoria to work with companies impacted by the closure of the Hazelwood power station.
