Councillor Graeme Middlemiss is the current Mayor of the Latrobe City and was elected to this role in November 2018. Cr Middlemiss has served as a Councillor of the Latrobe City since the formation of the democratically elected Latrobe Shire/City in 1997, and was last elected to Council for a four year term in November 2016.

He currently holds the following positions as a representative of Latrobe City Council:

- Member of the Latrobe Valley Airport Board of Management (for 21 years)
- Executive Member/Treasurer of South East Australia Transport Strategy Inc (various positions including Vice President held over 21 year period)
- Latrobe City representative on Alliance of Councils for Rail Freight Development, known as the 'Rail Freight Alliance' (for 10 years)

In addition, he holds a number of other roles on council advisory committees such as Flora/Fauna Reserve Committee of Management, Access-all-abilities Playground Committee, Rail Service Committee, Motor Sports Committee, Yallourn North Retirement Units Committee of Management, 'Future Morwell' Project Committee etc. (changing and ongoing roles over a 21 year period).
